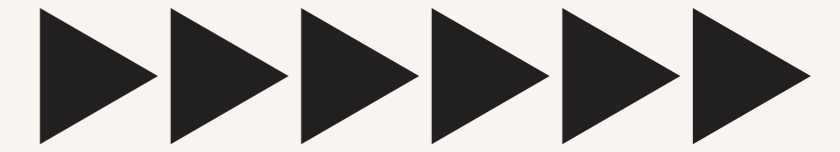
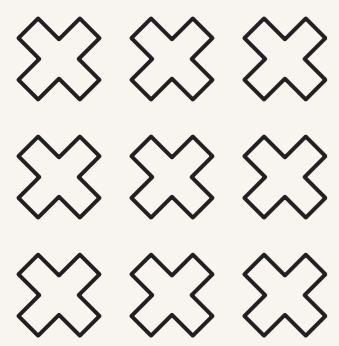




# Application Materials

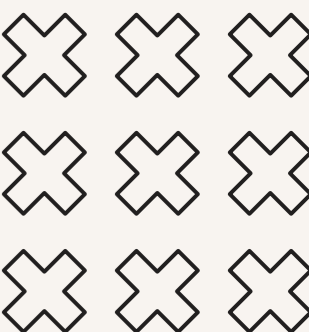




# Financial Planning



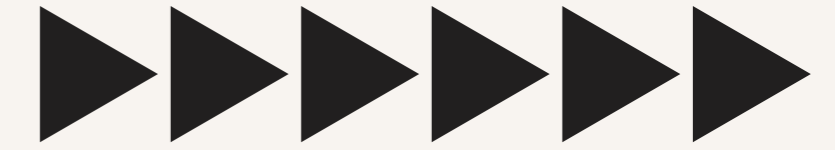
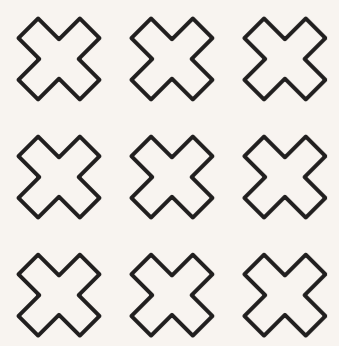

# Financial Planning

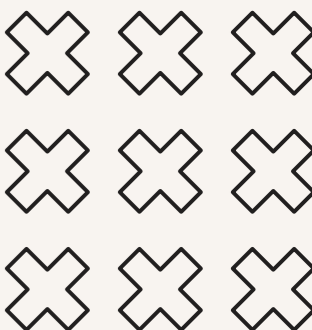
- To give a ballpark figure for fees in USA universities
- Tuition fees for international students at public universities - \$20,000 to \$40,000 per year for Bachelor's/ master's programs.  
Tuition fees for international students at Private Institutions- \$30,000 to \$60,000 or more per year for Bachelor's/master's programs
- An approximate range of monthly living expenses for international students in the USA:
- Rent: \$500 - \$2,500 (varies greatly by location and type of accommodation)
- Food: \$200 - \$500 Transportation: \$50 - \$200
- Health Insurance: \$50 - \$300
- Books and Supplies: \$50 - \$200 Personal Expenses: \$100 - \$300

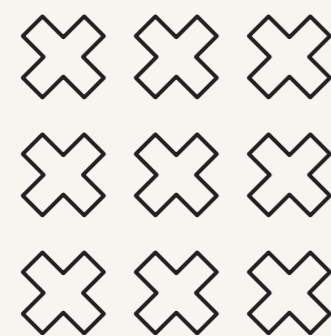




# Campus Life



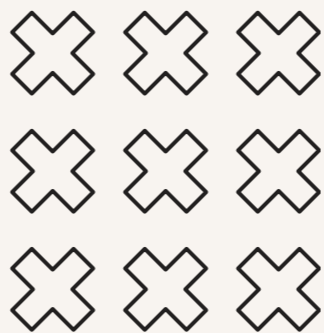
